 <b>Garlic</b>	10 cm	30 cm	Long	Plant very early in spring.
 <b>Eggplant</b>	40 cm	60 cm	Long	Keep 4 to 5 fruits per plant. Harvest when skin is shiny.
 <b>Beet</b>	5 cm	30 cm	Short Long	Plant as soon as the soil has warmed up (10 °C) and until July.
 <b>Broccoli</b>	40 cm	75 cm	Short	After harvest, keep the plants for a second harvest.
 <b>Carrot</b>	5 cm	45 cm	Short	Sow every 15 days from early May to June 15.
 <b>Celery</b>	20 cm	50 cm	Long	Mound the foot two weeks before harvest.
 <b>Brussels sprouts</b>	40 cm	80 cm	Long	Remove the leaves to promote growth. Pinch tip in late August.
 <b>Cauliflower</b>	40 cm	75 cm	Medium	When it reaches 7 cm in diameter, lift up and tie the leaves above.
 <b>Summer cabbage</b>	45 cm	60 cm	Long	Overly dry soil can cause the heads to burst.
 <b>Winter cabbage</b>	45 cm	60 cm	Long	Harvest when firm. Cut with a knife.
 <b>Pumpkin</b>	200 cm	250 cm	Long	Sow in hills of 3 seeds. Keep 2 to 4 fruits per plant.
 <b>Cucumber</b>	120 cm	120 cm	Short	Sow in hills of 5 seeds. Keep 3 plants per hill.
 <b>Squash</b>	100 cm	100 cm	Long	Zucchini is the only short-cycle squash.
 <b>Spinach</b>	10 cm	40 cm	Short	Sow in spring or late summer, might go to seed otherwise.
 <b>Broad beans</b>	20-30 cm	75-90 cm	Long	Sow in early May. Harvest when beans are swollen.
 <b>Beans</b>	10 cm	100 cm	Short	Grow on strings, netting or trellis.
 <b>Kale</b>	40 cm	40 cm	Short	Kale can be grown in a pot with annuals for its ornamental qualities.
 <b>Lettuce</b>	15 cm	30 cm	Short	Sow in spring or late summer, might go to seed otherwise.
 <b>Melon</b>	150 cm	200 cm	Long	Sow in hills of 3 seeds. Keep 3 to 4 fruits per plant.
 <b>Onion</b>	10 cm	30 cm	Short	Bend the stems down in late August.
 <b>Sweet pepper</b>	30 cm	45 cm	Long	Green sweet peppers are unripe sweet peppers.
 <b>Peas</b>	6 cm	80 cm	Short	Sow every 15 days from early May to June 15. Requires support.
 <b>Leek</b>	10 cm	80 cm	Long	Leek is tolerant to frost. In zone 7 and over, it can be harvested in winter.
 <b>Radish</b>	4 cm	25 cm	Short	Sow in early spring or late summer, might go to seed otherwise.
 <b>Tomatoes</b>	45-90 cm	45-90 cm	Long	Plant so the first leaves are close to the ground.
